

Annual Report 2010

It's time to report of the 'goings on' in the Dolphins and what a busy and successful season we have had. I'd like to start by thanking Michaela and Chris for organising the Channel Relay Teams. Secondly I'd like to thank Christian, Jim and Caroline who have liaised with the baths management over the new arrangements related to pool hire. Thirdly thanks to Larry, Sarah, Christian and Sandra who provided canoe cover at our Tuesday night training sessions. Finally, I'd like to thank all those who have helped at other times including coaching during the year.

The mileage swum outdoors this year has again been high at 543miles. Eve Fellows completed 67 miles in the season while cruising to many great results. In late August we managed to get two of the three potential teams across the channel, more later in the report. The **Anderson Trophy** this year was awarded to Mr. Christian Wade. Christian has been very active in the negotiation with Warrington Borough Council over the new arrangements for pool hire. He has also helped provide canoe cover at Budworth Training. In addition to acting as Chief Coach, Christian has found time to compete in many swims this season. The **Dolphin of the Year** is awarded to Eve Fellows, for an outstanding season in her first year as a senior. Eve won two BLDSA Championships and was part of the successful Team Pacific Channel Relay Team.

The Channel Relay week came and went and no team got anywhere near a pilots boat. A number of the swimmers went down to Dover in anticipation of the call, but the weather which had been bad for over a week got no better. As a result the slot passed and all team members return home. Now this delay presented a problem as some members had family holidays planned and this resulted in availability issues. As always happens at the most inopportune time we got a call from two of the pilots. Chris Carter mustered his team with Steve Connor not being available. However, the President's team was a little more difficult to organise as he was in Scotland at the Loch Lomond swim. The morning after the Lomond swim, he drove to Balloch to get a signal for his phone, parked up in a housing estate and rang and texted members of his team. This wasn't most popular with his wife who had planned a few days away from swimming. Anyway it was apparent that he wasn't available to get there, nor was Laura Holland who couldn't juggle work commitments, Adrian Moylan wasn't back from holiday and Sarah Beresford was praying for no delays in her flight home. So the ever dependable Michaela was asked by the President to go with Team Pacific and to help him out organising the crossing. After the request she sprang into action and organised the team and transport challenges to get the show was on the road.

At 2:30am on 31st August 2010, the two teams Pacific and Southern set off. Pacific had a team of 6 and Southern had a team of 7. Both teams were successful

There were a number of notable swims completed this season. Eve Fellows won Derwentwater & Lynn Regis ladies races, was came 3rd in her first Windermere swim and won Loch Earn 7mile race for the second year on the run. Laura Holland won the Llyn Padarn 4mile race and Charlotte Dickinson won the Wykeham 2mile race. Stuart Ainsworth finished second in the Derwentwater 2mile race. However, a special mention should be made about Joe Coy. Joe decided at the start of the season that this year was a 'fly' year. He completed a number of swims on Fly. The most impressive performance was his attempt on Windermere. These swims were truly impressive as I'm sure most of us just couldn't contemplate the challenge.

The Dee Mile again proved to be a popular swim with Michaela Richard retaining her title as Ladies All-Comers winner. Richard Walsh again narrowly missed out on the male equivalent.

Courtney Dean had some difficulty in achieving her 2 hour qualifying swim as every time she planned it she found that she got selected to play water polo to the country. She had a successful summer competing across Europe and just managed to fit in her Channel Relay crossing with Team Pacific.

Club Championships – Budworth and Albert Dock

The **Budworth Championships** were again successfully run by Michaela & Larry Richard whom I thank on behalf of all Dolphins. For the second year we limited the entry to 90 due to limitations on car parking. The club retained the Senior Team Award for the 12th year thanks to Martin Bosson, Eve Fellows and Richard Walsh. Joe Coy completed the swim on Fly. We had splendid help from Dolphins not swimming. Those who did swim competed well. **Martin Bosson** won the senior gents championship. Eight Dolphins completed their first 3 mile swim.

I was at the helm for the **Albert Dock Championships** as Dave Bowker was unavailable due to holiday commitments. I believe the championships were a great success with a record entry at 64. Many Dolphins taking part. **Graham Padgett** once again claimed the title of first male veteran in the 4 mile event with **Julie Mainwaring** being the first female veteran. **Michaela Richard** was first Dolphin home. The highlight of the 2mile swim was the close finish by three dolphins. **Amanda Reid** (speeding up weekly) burnt past **Stuart Ainsworth** and **Tony Fillingham**. Tony managed to pip Stuart to the touch. However, Stuart's first comments was "who was that who beat me and is he younger than me?"

Club Events – Budworth Handicap, Marbury Handicap and Pool Events

The **Boxing Day Dip** as usual resulted in an impressive spectacle. The course was the same and the competitors all completed the course. The winner this season was **Martin Bosson** who accelerated away on the last leg to finish with clear water behind him.

Budworth Handicap – Despite the wintry weather dragging on into spring, 27 swimmers entered the handicap. As usual the President arranged the course with help of Christian in a canoe. However, the estimate of 10 laps being equal to a mile proved to be way out. In fact probably 50% out, at approximately 1.5 miles. On the day the rain held off even though it was overcast. The water temperature was on the brisk side at 12.5°C. All but 2 swimmers completed the swim with the majority of Channel Relay members taking part. The winner of the swim was **Tony Fillingham** who ignored the President's estimated distance and was far more accurate with his own. He was only 2:46 minutes out against an average of 16 minutes. The coffee and bacon butties available at the sailing club house were welcomed by all.

Bob Keating & Dick Dickinson Handicaps were held at Fordton at the end of April. This year we returned to no juniors swimming in the Dick Dickinson Handicap. However, the Bob Keating had 12 seniors taking part. **Steve Connor** was the winner being only 10 seconds out on his predicted time.

The **Marbury Handicap** followed the same successful format as it has done for several years. 17 swimmers took part this year with the Presentation this being held over a buffet at the Antrobus Arms. Over the last few years predicted times of the winners have been extremely close to their actual time. This year's winner, **Adrian Moylan**, couldn't have been any closer finishing with the same time he predicted. The water temperature (20C+) was warm enough to even persuaded **Russ Masson** off the side into the water. As the saying goes 'great oaks grow from small acorns', watch this space for more action from Russ!!.

We had another successful **Postal Swim** claiming many gold medals. Once again our thanks are owed to Julie Mainwaring for organising the Dolphins swims and Alan Pomfret who organised it nationally.

At the Cheshire Masters the club finished as runners up. There were a number of notable swims with Russ Mason setting a county record in the 100 IM. The gents 4 x 50m IM Team 200/249 also set a county record. Overall we had 10 first places.

Summer Training at Budworth: Michaela organised summer training at Budworth on Tuesday Evenings. The sessions were well attended. Also we held a Thursday night swim on the 8th July to enable members of the Channel Relay teams to complete their 2 hour swim. The recent warm weather had transformed the lake into a greenish soup colour. There was no speed swimming, just a case of head up slow breaststroke for 2 hours. Then the following week saw cooler weather and heavy rain which resulted in the lakes quality being restored and training sessions continued into September. Following the last session swimmers retired to the 'Antrobus Arms' for some liquid refreshment. Thanks are due to Larry and Christian for organising the canoe cover and laying the course each week.

Once again the Club has been very fortunate to receive so much support throughout the year from members and friends whether to participate in swimming or to turn up and help. Can I thank all of you?

In the Senior Men's 3 mile Martin Bosson was first, alongside Alice, for a neck and neck finish. Graham Padgett was 1st Veteran Gent. Warrington Dolphins won the senior winning team trophy they which Martin Bosson, Eve Fellows and Richard Walsh. Julie Trevor won the Ladies 3 mile Breaststroke and Alec Glover won the Gents 3 mile Breaststroke, at his first attempt at 3 miles. Congratulations to all the Dolphin swimmers who entered and completed their swims, some of them being their first open water swim.

The 1-mile events were won by Katie Pierce of Rykneld SC and Ian Smith also of Rykneld. Well done to fellow dolphins Kay Gorzko and Chris Carter who came 2nd and Stuart Ainsworth who came 3rd.

The Junior 2-mile events were won by Hawys Hatley and Jack Colley. Both had excellent races. Scarborough Swimming Club were well represented this year and won the Junior Team Event. The Tri 1-mile was won by Sean Kinsey.

The presentations ended a very wet day.

Finally, the Merit Of The Mere shield was awarded to Larry Richard, for his continuing contribution and support he gives to the Warrington Dolphins LDSC, especially the Budworth Championships. I would like to say a huge thank you for his support and advice.
